1. General Overview

Manuscripts submitted to IJIAMS must be written in clear, concise English. We adhere to the IEEE two-column format to ensure a uniform and professional appearance. Manuscripts that do not strictly follow these guidelines may be returned to the authors for correction before review.

2. Document Structure & Layout

Parameter	Specification
Paper Size	A4 (210mm x 297mm)
Margins	Top: 19mm, Bottom: 43mm, Side: 13mm
Columns	Two columns (except Title/Abstract)
Column Width	88mm (3.45 in)
Spacing	4mm (0.17 in) between columns
Font	Times New Roman
Title Size	24 pt, Bold, Centered
Body Text	10 pt, Regular, Justified

3. Section Headings

Headings should be numbered using Roman numerals (I., II., III.).

Level 1: Small Caps, Centered (e.g., I. INTRODUCTION)

Level 2: Italic, Left-Aligned, Alphabetical (e.g., A. *Sub-heading*)

4. Figures and Tables

Figures: Must be high resolution (300 dpi). Captions go *below* the figure (e.g., Fig. 1. Proposed Architecture).

Tables: Captions go *above* the table (e.g., TABLE I. EXPERIMENTAL DATA). Avoid using vertical lines in tables.

5. Citation and References

IJIAMS follows the IEEE citation style. References must be numbered in square brackets [1] and appear sequentially in the text.
